#### Date for 2023 AGM

Our AGM will be held on 16<sup>th</sup> May at St Sebastians Parish Centre. As there are no Covid restrictions we will be able to hold the meeting in person this year and we will also look to provide the ability to join the meeting remotely via Zoom. Further details of the AGM will be sent out as soon as they are available.

### Sponsorship renewals

As you have already been informed, our sponsorship fees are reluctantly increasing for the academic year which starts in January 2024.

In setting the new fee structure for 2024, the sponsorship team agreed that we should minimise the number of times sponsors are requested to:

- Change their standing for the basic fee (i.e. for tuition, lunches and scholastic materials).
- Make one-off donations (i.e. for entry requirements into S1 and S5 and exam registration for P7, S4 and S6).

As a result, the approach taken was to spread the cost of one-off requirements over a specific educational stage so that the basic fee covers these costs. This means that the only requests for one-off donations will be for boarding fees and expenses in P7.

From January 2024 the basic fees will be:

N-P7: £300 (£25 per month)

• \$1-\$4: £420 (£35 per month)

• S5-S6: £480 (£40 per month)

A standing order form can be found by going to "Forms" at <a href="https://www.mityanacharity.org/">https://www.mityanacharity.org/</a> and you need to organise this with your own bank. We hope that all sponsors will continue to support their sponsored child/children but if there is a problem please speak to us as soon as possible so that we can seek a new sponsor for your child. Sadly, if a sponsor ceases to support a child, the child will have to drop out of school as we do not have the funds to take over their fees. If you are in this situation a solution could be to share the costs between one or more of your friends so that your sponsored child can continue

with their education. The families are immensely grateful for all you are doing to help their children and the difference sponsorship makes to the whole family.

As a result of the very generous sponsorship arrangements we are able to provide an education for almost 300 children as shown below. We would like to continue and expand the invaluable help that is given to provide a crucial education.

#### **Christmas Presents**

Our partner PaCT monitors the impact of these facilities and has produced the following information on the performance of the facilities during November 2022. These are very tangible benefits from the work the charity does in Uganda.

#### Menstrual Health Management

Menstrual Hygiene Management remains an issue in Uganda especially for girls at school. Lack of knowledge, lack of facilities, prejudice and a lack of information all help contribute to girls missing education amongst other things. In our last issue we talked about an initiative to help girls make reusable sanitary pads that are cost effective and to construct girl friendly latrines. The Mityana Charity in conjunction with Orange House at Wellington are looking at a multi-faceted approach to continue to address the situation. We hope to be able to announce the rollout of this in future newsletters.
